What do you think of what Jesus said? Is there any truth to it?

Jesus said, "Whoever wants to become great among you must **be like a servant**, and whoever wants to be first must **be like a slave of all**. For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many."



Challenge

Someone might say that shooting lasers from your eyes or sticking to walls would make you a hero... but **VILLAINS** have powers too and they aren't heroes! So it can't be the **powers** that make the hero, so what is it? Surely **it's the heart behind the powers to use them for good** – that makes the hero.

Obviously you can't stick to walls (unless you're keeping it quiet), but you might have the same **courage** and **compassion** that any hero does.

So **will you do what you can to help people?** We might not think they're very significant, but those little 'hero moments' can make a HUGE impact when we do what we can to help someone out. We all love heroes, so why not be one?
