## Music through time

#### Overview (including links to Big Ideas)

This unit aims to give pupils an opportunity to learn about the Western Classical Tradition (3 periods that are the focus for Eduqas GCSE) through listening but then also theory and practical work. They will look at a typical piece from each period and develop their understanding of the periods through one of the Big ideas. Through this work they will also develop a greater understanding of TEXTURE and FORM

Listening and appraising to a range of music to illustrate what is understood as the Western Classical tradition. Listen/Appraise - Vivaldi Lute concerto, Mozart Rondo Alla Turca, Berlioz Symphonie fantastique Performing - Rondo Alla Turca

Composing - short musical pictures in minor key in response to Berlioz Symphonie Fantastic March to the scaffold

## Links to Prior and Future learning (Why this? Why now?)

#### Prior -

Having revised work on rhythm, pupils will know revise and extend their knowledge of pitch in the treble clef. Performing music in all grade 1 keys and A minor (Grade 2).

#### Further -

Having introduced major and minor tonality in the next term we will be looking at other types of scales (Blues scale) and building on knowledge of accompaniments (Chords and Bass)
