Statement from St Michael's CE High School, Crosby

St Michaels and the Liverpool Diocesan School Trust (LDST) while disappointed with the Ofsted rating accept it. Ahead of the inspection senior leadership were working with school staff on a robust action plan to tackle many of the issues Ofsted noted. Ofsted recognised that this had not been fully realised before the inspection however we have continued that work as it gives a platform to move forward.

An important part of leading improvements is strong stable leadership and under our Executive Headteacher we believe we have the ability to steer the school to be the best for its students and staff. The trust fully supports the plans and is investing in the development of the school.

The central investment is the school's curriculum which the report noted alongside a range of other features including SEND provision, pupil's personal development, careers provision and attendance.

We were also pleased that Ofsted noted our effective safeguarding and the calm orderly atmosphere around the school.

St Michaels, supported by LDST will learn from this report and work on our actions to bring about the positive change we all want to see for the pupils and staff at the school
