1	Belonging	A sense of fitting in or feeling like you are an important member of a group.	16	Evaluate	Form an idea of the amount, number, or value of; assess.
2	Community	The condition of sharing or having certain attitudes and interests in common.	17	Religious Community	A religious community is a group of people who practice the same religion.
3	Body of Christ	Has 2 different meanings: Jesus' words over the bread at the Last Supper that "This is my body". The term given by the Apostle to refer to the Christian Church.	18	Religious Order	An organized community of people who live in some way set apart from society, devoted to their religion.
4	Trinity	God in three ways; Father, Son and Holy Spirit.	19	Christian	A person who has received Christian baptism or is a believer in Christianity.
5	Incarnation	God in human form (Jesus).	20	Eucharist	The Christian service in which bread and wine are consecrated and consumed, to remember the last supper.
6	Faith	Complete trust or confidence in someone or something	21	Theology	Religious beliefs.
7	Salvation	Deliverance from sin and its consequences, believed by Christians to be brought about by faith in Jesus.	22	Ethnicity	The fact or state of belonging to a social group that has a common national or cultural tradition.
8	Gospel	The record of Christ's life and teaching in the first four books of the New Testament. Literally means 'Good news'.	23	Virtues	Behaviour showing high moral standards.
9	Cultural Diversity	The existence of a variety of cultural or ethnic groups within a society.	24	Local Community	A group of interacting people living in a common location.
10	Religious Identity	The sense of group membership to a religion and the importance of this group membership.	25	National Community	A whole nation as a community.
11	Religious Artifacts	An object that has religious significance.	26	International Community	The countries of the world considered collectively.
12	Culture	The ideas, customs, and social behaviour of a particular people or society.	27	Armistice Day	The anniversary of the armistice of 11 November 1918, now replaced by Remembrance Sunday in the UK and Veterans Day in the US.
13	Cultural Traditions	A tradition is a belief or behaviour passed down within a group or society with symbolic meaning or special significance with origins in the past.	28	Religious symbol	An icon to represent a specific religion or part of a specific religion.
14	Reflect	Think deeply or carefully about.	29	New Testament	The second part of the Christian Bible. It includes the four Gospels.
15	Critically	An analysis of the merits and faults of something.	30	Old Testament	The first part of the Christian Bible, they make up the chief texts of the law, history, prophecy, and wisdom literature of the ancient people of Israel.
