1	Affiliation	Feeling connected or associated with a person, religion, organisation or team.	16	Madonna	1. The Virgin Mary / 2. A picture, statue, or medal of Mary / 3. An idealized, righteous and beautiful woman.
2	Atonement	Restoring the relationship between people and God through the life, death and resurrection of Jesus.	17	Marxism	Marxism is a political and economic way of organizing society. It is based on the theories of Karl Marx and Friedrich Engels.
3	Bishop	A senior member of the Christian clergy, usually in charge of a wide geographical area called a diocese. Bishops have the authority to grant Holy Orders.	18	Nike	The Greek goddess who personifies victory.
4	Chapter	A meeting held by the clergy.	19	Oppressed	Subjected to harsh and controlling treatment.
5	Consecrated	Having been made or declared sacred.	20	Revelation	God showing himself to believers, this is the only way anybody can really know anything about God.
6	Creation	The act by which God brought the universe into being.	21	Sacred	Connected with God or a god or dedicated to a religious purpose and so deserving veneration. "Sacred Rites".
7	Crisis	1. A time of intense difficulty or danger / 2. A time when a difficult or important decision must be made.	22	Salvation	Deliverance from sin and its consequences, believed by Christians to be brought about by faith in Jesus.
8	Doctrine	A belief or set of beliefs held and taught by a religious group, political party, or other group.	23	Sanctuary	1. The most sacred part of a religious building (such as the part of a Christian church in which the altar is placed) / 2. A place of refuge and protection.
9	Eve	First woman made by God.	24	Secular	Not connected with religious or spiritual matters-used to describe things, activities, or attitudes that have nothing to do with religion.
10	Faith	1. Complete trust or confidence in someone or something / 2. Strong belief in the doctrines of a religion, based on spiritual conviction rather than proof.	25	Service	1. A ceremony of religious worship according to a prescribed form / 2. The action of helping or doing work for someone.
11	Gouranga	A Hare Krishna mantra meaning "be happy". It is a Sanskrit word (Sanskrit is an Indian Language).	26	Thanksgiving	The expression of gratitude, especially to God.
12	Hare Krishna	A branch of Hinduism, formally known as Gaudiya Vaishnavism. Its name comes from its chant — Hare Krishna — which devotees repeat over and over.	27	Theological	Relating to the study of the nature of God and religious belief.
13	Icon	An image of Christ, his mother, or a saint painted onto wooden panels. Used by some Orthodox Christian churches .	28	Veneration	To show great respect towards something.
14	Incarnation	The embodiment of God the Son in human flesh as Jesus Christ.	29	Yahoo	Comes from the name of the Canaanite God.
15	Koinonia	A Greek word that occurs 20 times in the bible. It means "fellowship, sharing in common, communion."	30	Yahweh	Hebrew name of God used in the Bible. The name was revealed to Moses as four Hebrew consonants (YHWH) and is believed by many Jewish people as too sacred to be spoken.
